



Teacher Qualifications and Responsibilities

Teacher Qualifications –

1. Must be an ordained minister, a Seminary or Bible College professor, or equivalent life experience qualification (LEQ).
2. Must have completed at least 60 hours of Bible College or equivalent training and experience.
3. Must be an experienced Bible teacher, teaching at college level (three years or more).
4. Complete World Reach application process with three letters of recommendation, one of which must be from the individual's current active ministering pastor.
5. Exceptions to the above qualifications must be approved by the Bible Institute International Director and the World Reach General Director.

Teacher Responsibilities -

1. Raise own support for transportation, subsistence, passport/visa, language interpreters, and World Reach administrative fee.
2. Commit to teaching assignment from 7 to 10 days at a time depending on the course taught.
3. Use World Reach approved curriculum to plan classes, or obtain approval from the Bible Institute International Director to use self-developed curriculum.
4. Be prepared to preach at local in-country churches (if requested).
5. Make no obligations or commitments on behalf of World Reach. If a teacher desires to help individuals, churches, or local entities in the teaching area overseas, he must obtain approval through World Reach International Headquarters before doing so.
6. Submit an After Teaching Report to the Bible Institute International Director after each course taught.

7. Obtain immunizations information and immunizations through own health department/doctor.
8. Obtain own passport. Headquarters will assist in administratively obtaining visas for teachers where necessary.
9. Obtain temporary health insurance for the overseas teaching period (if desired).
