OPPORTUNITIES IN BRASOV PUBLIC SCHOOLS



As I've shared with you before, I work with a non-profit organization called Pro Vita. They give us a network of support to take programs to the public schools, especially to the parents. However, it also opens doors to work with the students. Adina, a student disciple of our daughter, Keren, invited us to her Spanish class to give a program about values. This gave us an opportunity to support her testimony among her fellow students as she shares

her faith with them. Please pray that the Lord will allow us to present a testimony to the students every time we have the opportunity to share our programs with them.

WORLD REACH BIBLE INSTITUTE

Our mission board, World Reach, has Bible Institutes in many countries and we have started one here in Brasov. During the month of May, we had the second preliminary class to determine if we have enough students to start a permanent institute. It takes two years to go through the program. We have invited mostly church leaders and young people who need to be prepared in systematic knowledge of the Bible. Most of the Bible institutes here prepare people to a pastoral level, awarding doctoral degrees. However, the intermediate leadership of the church does not have to be prepared to serve and we would like to offer that opportunity. For now, I'm the coordinator of this class, hoping this forms a bond between the churches and World Reach. Please pray the Lord will give us grace in serving these young leaders.
