## Dear Friends,

Greetings, all the way from Siguatepeque, wishing God's most richest blessings upon you. May this letter find you well and enjoying success in each area of your lives.

It has been quite a while since we last wrote. We apologize, for we feel debtors to our commitment with you. We praise God for keeping us busy in His work and we're very thankful for everything He has done in us. We have gone through some hardships, but God has shown His faithfulness. We want to testify of those great things He has made use of to bring tremendous blessings into our lives and others.

## Danny's Health

We want to thank you for all your prayers and beautiful inspiring emails. They have encouraged us a lot. It is so special to know that there have been



people praying in many different countries, such as: Honduras, Guatemala, Mexico and the United States. We have truly felt your prayers, as we can see the magnitude of God's response. We praise God for the wonderful outcome of Danny's right-hand surgery. The wonderful thing is that it has been recovering three times faster than the left hand. Doctors have also confirmed good results from both surgeries.

We realize there is still a while for full recovery, which should still take some months; however, Danny has been able to start working again. He has been limited a bit,



but at least he is back to work, as he quotes: *"With the New Hands God has given me."* The changes in weather have not favored the surgeries at all; but, in general, Danny is doing much better. To God be the Glory! We want to thank each one of you who kindly gave financially to help with these tremendous medical expenses. Although we cannot pay back directly, God sure can! And we are sure that He will reward generously each one of you according to His sovereign will. Thank you so much!

## The Joy of Service

God has been faithful! He answered a major prayer request we had at the end of 2006. In spite of many problems experienced by



many of the women involved in this program, this year we have begun with an attendance of 40 women. We are reaching approximately 350 women throughout



Honduras. This number does not include the women involved in the different program extensions already at work. We will let you know how many there are in our

next letter. There is, however, a number of women who wish to study but, due to their low financial incomes, they're not able to do so. The Joy of Service

has opened a fund which can help with these hardships. This fund depends upon people who have given to this cause and is an invitation we want to extend



to you, as well. If you feel you want to contribute, please write to us to find out the appropriate way to transfer your help to these needy women.

## New Teaching Ministry Opportunities

This year, the Bible Seminary from Honduras asked Danny to help in the training given to leaders and some pastors by way of the Music School. It is interesting to know that in the past there has been little or no orientation given to students regarding the significance of music in the ministry of the Lord. Danny has challenged himself and God is honoring the efforts made daily, beginning with a short devotional based on 1 and 2 Timothy. The students are being



bombarded during the day, not only with music, but also with their role in the church. Music is very important, but it is SECONDARY to our relationship with the Lord so that we

can carry out a music ministry with His divine support. This alone will contribute to minimizing many of the

problems which has caused church splitting throughout the Latin church here in Honduras. Danny is also teaching the course "Music and Liturgy", which is



offered to all first-year students and to the Music School students. This course has been very useful for pastors and leaders. It helps them to understand the problem that many pastors have today. Music is considered to be of very little or no



importance. This course is giving some solutions to many problems which, at its worst, have caused many churches to split.

We ask that you help us pray that God will use Danny in teaching during the first two trimesters of this year 2007.



(We will tell you later in this letter the reason for teaching only 2 out of 3 trimesters.)

### Siguatopeque's Fire Department

We praise God for this beautiful ministry. The lives of these men are so hard at times and, unfortunately, there has been no help for them. For example, you might remember Melgar. He lost his mother at the end of 2006. Only 2 months later, he also lost his father. Doctors state that it could have happened for many reasons; but one could be because of depression due to the loss of his wife.

God's Word has been truly helpful to them. The encouragement given can be perceived in their faces each time we study the Bible and many have exposed very personal issues for Danny to pray for. Although these issues cannot be revealed in letters like this, we know God knows all the details, for which we ask that you pray, knowing that God will answer accordingly. Thank you so much for your prayers on behalf of these men. They have always responded with a smile when Danny has told them that special people like you are praying for them and, although you're not given any details, they have declared that they feel the effects of prayer. Thank you for praying!

### Local Church

Our ministry in our local church is coming along. We praise God for allowing us to be useful in: *Bible Teaching, Women's Ministry, Music and Writing Sunday School Materials for Children*. We ask that you pray for us, as we have felt God speaking to us regarding the possible unifying of efforts with a new congregation that has just begun and needs a lot of help with Bible teaching. However, this may take some time; it could be next year, if God doesn't call us there earlier. For now, it is something to pray about. Thank you for helping us pray so that we may allow God to lead us into the right decision.

### Trip to the United States

After taking time to pray, we have seen God's answer in the confirmation for our trip to the United States this year. Each one of the key people that we've made contact with has confirmed our proposal, not only in the matter of dates, but also in the purpose of our trip.

Our goal is to minister to the saints during our visits, which will be between three and five days in each place. Since the four of us are traveling together, we're praying that Damary will also be a blessing by reaching out to the women that she meets. We thank you who are a part of our list of contacts, who have understood the purpose of our trip and have agreed to the gathering of people together during our

visit in order to hear about our vision for ministry and may possibly be added to our 'Prayer and Financial Support Team'. This will help us to be able to continue ministering in our present field, as well as to go "beyond" where God once called us to go.

We have, by faith, proposed traveling dates. (The reality of our situation is that there is no budget for this trip just yet.) God willing, we should be able to travel **August 14 - October 31**. We thank all of you who have accepted our proposal and have agreed to help by hosting our family during our stay. Our numerous flight tickets and a car rental between Oregon and California are quite expensive, but we realize that our Lord of all riches is He who has allowed for all of our present confirmations. So, we will trust that He will also provide for all the travel expenses. If you feel God's calling to help sponsor this trip, we're sure He will reward all your efforts made on our behalf.


A major problem we had to overcome for our trip to the States was that of Sammy's U.S. Visa expiring before our trip began. We praise God that on February 23 God used the assigned Embassy Counsel (who was very respectful and approving of our cause) and granted a renewal for his visa. On February 27, we received Sammy's passport and found out that they had given him 5 years on his visa. Praise the Lord!

We ask that you please pray that we may be used by God wherever He will have us visit and will be a blessing for His people. Pray that we may have a great fellowship with our brethren in Christ that already are part of our 'Prayer and Support Team' and that we may find additional support for our ministry.
