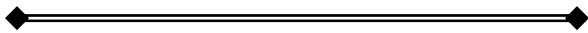

1. We're sure you will remember our prayer request regarding the need for God's provision to help cover the costs of our last trip to the United States last year. God is more than faithful! He answered our prayers and allowed some angels to help cover all the costs. (*We still don't know the name of one of these angels, but we know that God does.*)

Thank you so much, brethren, for all your offerings! Our hearts and faces were in tears when we received such news. Let us remember: "God is Faithful!"

Likewise, God has also provided for all of our family needs so far this year. We know He is faithful and won't leave us. We always trust Him for His divine provision in each area of our lives.

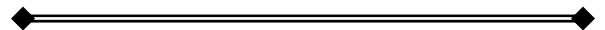
2. As you may remember, at the beginning of this year we asked that you pray regarding an increase in the cost for the "Joy of Service" study materials. To our surprise, we experienced an incredible response from our students – teachers of this program.

We praise God that "The Joy of Service" began its 7th year of ministry this year. By the grace of God, we continue to grow each day. This year (as we

anticipated a drop in the attendance), we began by reaching 435 women. Five more groups outside the Siguatepeque area adds up to this sum, all of which were also mentioned at the beginning of this year.

3. God has begun to open new doors here in Honduras regarding future church seminar commitments. He allowed Danny to share his first seminar on February 24, which was given to a whole congregation here in Siguatepeque. Later on in this letter, we will share more information regarding other upcoming scheduled seminars in April.

4. We praise God for a group of children who attend the Awana Club at Life Community Church in North Carolina. They helped us out this year by way of many Home School Materials for our children, as well as Ministry Materials. They also helped us by providing some medicine and food, which is difficult to find in Honduras due to the high costs. We thank all the families involved. Their efforts made on behalf of our family were a great blessing to us!



PRAYER REQUESTS

1. **Health**

This beginning period of the year is quite dry here in Honduras. The place where we live happens to be very dusty. This has brought many respiratory problems to all of us, which obviously keeps us from carrying out some of our ministry commitments. Thank you for praying! ☺

2. **Ministry**

Just as God has provided a beautiful and diverse ministry, we ask that you pray for God to effectively use us and strengthen our lives spiritually and physically in order to bring forth blessings and edification to the body of God.

God has two Church Seminars and one Pastoral Seminar in the northwestern part of the country (Sta. Barbara). This last one is a key seminar as it may help open more doors for ministry which have remained closed until today. The subjects to be taught are very sensitive within churches and carry some negative music influences from the Honduran past. We ask that you pray for God to grant Danny wisdom and that he may speak truly from the Word of God, which gives us direction on this issue.

3. Satan Attacks

We all know that Satan is not happy with the efforts made towards God's work. We praise God for the World Reach ministry team that we have in Honduras, which has been used by God to benefit the Church in both Honduras and Nicaragua. We ask that you pray that God will continue to help us and give us wisdom and protection to always carry out a good testimony worthy of God's acceptance.

Although we all suffer the enemy's attacks in different ways, we also know that we can trust Him, whom we serve. Thank you for praying for this special prayer request.

4. Siguatpeque's Fire Department

We thank God for the special ministry to the Fire Department in Siguatpeque. Danny is privileged to reach this needy group of men week after week. Some of you might have heard or seen on the news the fatal bus accident that took place the last week of March. It took the lives of 28 people. This place is about 40 minutes away from Siguatpeque. The Fire Department was urged to assist with this emergency, together with all kinds of emergency teams. All the work done on behalf of these people suffering the agony of death and those that lost their lives was quite traumatic for these men. Danny helped bring some peace to their hearts and encouraged them in their faith. We're alive today, but we do not know about tomorrow. *(Please read the special prayer request at the end.)*

One day, while we visited a local drugstore, the lady who attended us said she had seen Danny on the nights he goes there. She asked if this was something he did on a regular basis and Danny answered positively. She then expressed her happiness to know that someone had taken on the

burden to reach these men and encourage them in their ongoing difficult situations. Please pray for God to continue to use Danny to help these men see God's will for their lives.

5. The Joy of Service



We ask that you pray for the leaders outside the central group: Argentina, Debora and Ana Dia in Tegucigalpa, Dixie in San Pedro Sula and Raquel in Siguatpeque. This last group will be seeking to minister to both single women and single mothers.

This year's first trimester we're studying James and, of course, this will bring all types of hardships. In fact, we're already beginning to deal with some of them. Please pray that we may come out victorious.

6. Our Family

We thank God for our family, the unity we experience and the ministry that we can all carry out together. We ask that you pray that we may remain close together always and for God to grant us wisdom to have a balance between ministry and family time.

SPECIAL REQUEST

We ask that you pray for the families of the victims of a bus accident (*mentioned previously*) which took the lives of 28 people. These families now face serious difficulties as they lost sons, daughters and, in two cases, both parents of the family. They're all very poor families who not only have the financial burden, but also a strong spiritual need.

Danny and two other men from our local church accompanied our pastor on a trip to take some food, as well as spiritual support. Please pray that fair justice is applied to the bus owner and bus driver. Both have the support of the victims' families. However, the authorities want to press all charges possible, including a life sentence to the bus driver.

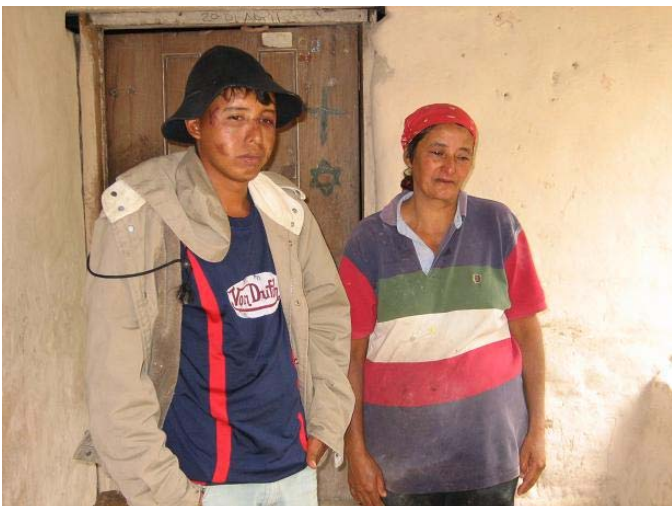
We also thank you for all your letters and emails, which always encourage us. This, in turn, helps us be efficient in our prayers for you. Thank you for sharing your burdens with us.
