As soon as we arrived...

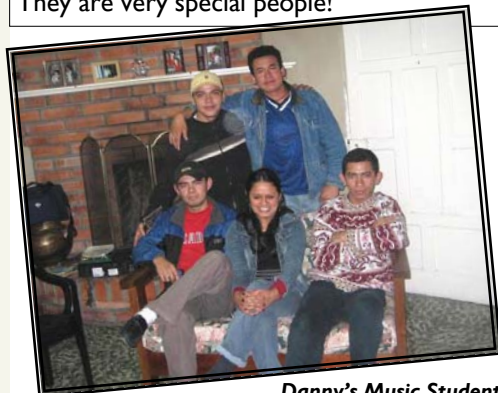


Dear Family and Friends,

the midst of trials and different daily matters. Praise God for such a blessing!

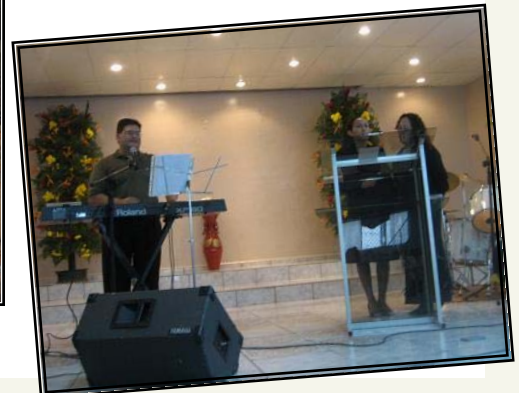


Nov. 11-13
