Dear Brothers and Friends,

Today we are glorifying God for He is faithful and just. In the midst of this difficult situation in Honduras, He is manifesting Himself; allowing us to reach out to more people with His Gospel.

We want to thank you because, thanks to your prayers, God is able to manifest Himself with power. Thank you, beloved brothers, for your care and love towards our family.

It has now been several months since we started with the new group of men with whom we share from the Word and pray together. We praise God for the growth of this group because now we are already thinking of training new leaders to start new groups. We ask your prayers for these new groups of men.

We also want to thank both God and you that the group of people in Balibrea attending the family group is growing. Now, we have the need for chairs and a larger meeting place to get together. We are even praying for a piece of property in order to build a building where we can have our services and the children's classes. We ask for your prayers with regards to this ministry; that God will provide the means to buy new chairs, a piece of property and the means to build a facility on that property.

We are also working towards the training of new leaders to be able to teach classes and Bible studies in Balibrea. Please pray for these people, that God will guide them.

Our Activities

Carlos Daniel has already finished his school year and we praise God that he did well in his classes. He will be in the fifth grade next year. Now, he is going out with me doing evangelism work. This past August 26, he turned 10 years of age.

Noely is now going through the ninth grade and is doing well. She is participating with the classes at the Heroes Club ministry at Christian Family Center and is also involved in the youth group of our church. She is recuperating from the removal of one of her toe nails on her right foot. In September, she went to the doctor who discovered a small cyst on her right ovary. Please pray that God will heal this problem. On December 3, she will be fifteen years of age.

Reina is finishing up teaching her classes at the public school. We praise God for her improvement with the pain of her bones. She is only presenting difficulties in her knees. We pray to God that He will provide the money to buy her medicines on time.

Noel has his visitation and consolation ministry, for which we praise God. Every Tuesday, there are meetings taking place in Balibrea where the Word is shared and prayers are lifted up. Also, every Monday and Friday we have meetings with two different groups of men. It is a special time in which men (as sons of God) pray and share the Word. Each group has grown and for that we praise God. We ask your prayers for this ministry that God has given to Noel. The first week of November, Noel will be teaching a class on counseling in Nueva Guinea, Nicaragua.

Our Prayer Requests

- 1- About 9 years ago, Pastor Jorge Espinal and Noel started the project of planting a new church which, thanks to God, is now called Christian Family Center. Pastor Espinal is now very sick. He has a tumor outside and around his pancreas and is in need of surgery. We ask your prayers for this servant of God, that He will provide the blessing of healing, as well as the financial means to provide for the surgery and medicines.
- 2- The growth of the new church in Balibrea - We need a piece of property and a building where we can meet.
- 3- The health of Reina and Noel, as well as Noely (the cyst outside her right ovary). Also, the emotional healing of Daniel.
- 4- That God will provide the financial means to realize our ministry here and in Nicaragua.
- 5- An appropriate vehicle for our ministry here in Honduras.
- 6- We praise God that Reina and Daniel have finished their school period. We also honor Him for His faithfulness in the midst of this economical and political difficulty in Honduras.
- 7- We ask your prayers for the negotiations in the crisis here between the political groups. It is not very clear the direction that they will take and the last Sunday of November will be the elections of the authorities of Honduras.
