God has shown Himself to be very faithful! We believe that God has provided a house to use for 4 months in the Locust, North Carolina area. That is a huge answer to prayer. Praise His name!

Here is another list for your daily prayers:

- ▶ We need to find a family to stay in our home here in Siguatpeque. It is a lot of responsibility.
- ▶ Also, we need to find a vehicle to use for the 4 months that we are in the States. We must travel throughout North Carolina, as well as a trip to Bristol, Tennessee and Birmingham, Alabama.
- ▶ Moreover, we still are lacking in contributions to be able to travel. Airline tickets are going to run our family a little more than \$4000.

CD RECORDING FINISHED (Praise the Lord!)

We have just recently finished recording a new music CD. It includes 11 original compositions and Danny Ceballos (a World Reach team member) has finished working on the final mix and the mastering. The only thing we lack now is a couple of minor mix changes and then the duplication. Tim hopes to be able to duplicate at least a 1000 of these when we are in the States. Our church is a constant blessing, as well as a challenge. We are growing numerically and slowly maturing. Pray for our congregation, that each person's level of commitment to Christ and His church will increase.

In the coming year, we have set a goal for planting a new rural community church about 45 minutes from here. A dental team from Birmingham, Alabama will be with us March 18 - 23. This will be our first formal contact with these rural communities that we hope to reach for Christ. Please pray that God will use CFC to reach many for His glory.
