Classes with the kids have been challenging for us and the kids because we started a new class. This opened the opportunity and need of a new teacher. So, we challenged ones from the "Support Group" to teach the Word of God in the 9 to 12 year old class. We thank God because we know He is preparing new future leaders.



We also thank God that Mario (one of the members of our Support Group) has gone to the Bible Seminary located in the Arequipa region of Peru. There, he will prepare himself to serve God in a better way.

We are also collaborating with the children's club "Joyas Presiosas" in our church and helping our leaders teach the young people.



Last month, we finished our support with the young people and we started with the young adult group in our church, "The Rock". We hope God uses us to be a blessing to these young adults and to be helpful to our pastor and leaders in our beloved church.



We ask for your prayers because at the beginning of the school year it was a challenge to prepare daily lessons. We asked for God's wisdom to administrate our time well and also take time as a married couple. The truth is, as we are learning to balance our time with more responsibilities, it is necessary to maintain our relationship as a couple as well.
