Carapongo

This continues to be a difficult time for us: 1) The house we have been using is under construction and we haven't used it for almost two months. We are meeting in the park. 2) Recently, they began construction of a bypass just before you get to Carapongo. This has caused a lot of traffic and makes us arrive late for the Bible Club.



All of this has discouraged us a little; but, in spite of everything, the children continue to come because they are interested in continuing to learn more of the Bible. This gives us the motivation to continue.

I will be meeting with brother Jaime (owner of the house) to see if we will be able to continue there.

The truth is, the house has been finished and furnished in order to rent it. Personally, I don't think that it's in any condition for a children's club.

Brothers, please pray for this place and for the group of helpers going with us. Pray they will learn to serve in comfort and discomfort, just as they have been doing.

For this reason, we have been checking prices of properties that could perhaps serve in the future to construct our own place because now it seems to me that we will no longer be "local" so to speak.



In this difficult situation, we are understanding that God wants us to be independent. We are praying for this. We are new in this area of church planting.

Brothers, the price range for the properties are between \$14,000 and \$20,000USD. This includes only properties with electricity, water and sewer. If any of you would be interested in helping us to purchase one of these properties (in addition to praying for this ministry), please let us know through our Director Timothy Prewitt and the World Reach Mission.

I also want to share with you that, as a husband, I am thinking of Evelyng's pregnancy in this situation. For this reason, we are in a dilemma regarding our decision of what God wants.

As for our personal lives, we are living in my parents' home for now. Although we are adding onto our own apartment (thanks to God's provision), it's going very slowly as God's hand is working. We would like to finish the house and begin living more independently, although we thank God for using my parents to give us a roof over our heads for the moment.

In order to finish the apartment just enough to be able to live there, we still need at least the two main doors. We haven't been able to get them yet because we've had more expenses with Evelyn's pregnancy; her doctor visits and associated costs.

We also have the desire to finish one of the rooms for our baby that is on the way. According to our estimate, the baby will be born somewhere around December 25. We have only a few months to finish preparing for when the baby comes. Brothers, please pray for this. We need your support and intercession to our Lord.

We continue with our discipleship, with the cell groups and with teaching the youth. Evelyng is also helping with the counseling in the Prenatal Center and I am teaching in the church's Bible Academy. If God allows, I will soon travel to the north of the country to continue helping with the Mobile Bible Institute. I ask you, brothers, to pray that I will know even more how to balance my time and care for my wife in the way God commands in these times.

Brothers, we want to be as sincere and transparent as possible and we thank God for all the support that you give us. For our part, we want to give our best as long as God allows us to serve Him.
