Carapongo

In spite of having to continue the Children's Club in the park, we rejoice in this ministry. God is using it to form not only ourselves, but also the young people that are serving alongside us as they continue teaching the children's classes with the same enthusiasm and willingness. This week, we have another combined program with the children's clubs from all our different church plants here in our La Roca Church. For approximately a year now, we have had horrible traffic around Carapongo and last week we arrived an hour late because of it. Returning to the church with the youth who helped us, we arrived two hours late which caused them to miss the Youth Group they attend each Saturday. Please pray about this. However, we are thankful for everything and we don't want to stop seeing God work.

We continue discipling the young people and also a couple. We see a desire in them to learn more and this motivates us. We are also taking advantage of the cell group to invite the men to participate in the Men's Conference we will have in La Roca.
