Thanks be given to our God because His grace reaches us daily and His faithfulness has been manifested in every area of our lives. We pray that you experience the eternal and wonderful love of our Lord. We want to share some of the practical ways the faithfulness and grace of Jesus Christ has manifested in our ministry. ## Teaching the Word of God

1. Alan has been teaching *History of the World* and *History of Honduras* in a local high school. This has been a great opportunity to teach from a Christian perspective and share a Biblical worldview about key events in our world. He has had the chance to help these kids on common questions and problems in their lives. Please **pray especially for Ivan**, a 10<sup>th</sup> grader. He is a brilliant young man, but is very confused about his present and future. **Pray that he will make the Lord the director of his life.**
2. Since 2007, we have been teaching a diploma program in the MBI for pastors and Bible Institute graduates in Managua, Nicaragua. In June, we will resume the teaching site in Nueva Guinea, Nicaragua (some 200 miles from Managua). Also, we are projecting to resume teaching in El Carreto and Chichicaste (both in Honduras). This means that this year we will have four MBI teaching sites. Thank God! Please **pray that God protects us during the constant trips and will provide for our**
- expenses. Also, pray that we **manage our time to prepare classes and we be taught first by the Lord in order to edify the pastors we are teaching.**
3. Dorys joined the teaching staff of the women's program *The Joy of Serving*. Right now, she is teaching James, both at a local seminary and at the church. As you can imagine, the Bible is making a big impact in many lives. **Please pray that God will keep transforming the lives and families of these women through His Word.**

## Production of Materials

1. Praise the Lord, we have a small team of brothers and sisters to produce the Children's Bible Lessons. Besides us, Javier Perelló, Esther Benites and WR's Tim Hagler are now writing lessons. We have produced forty lessons about the most-known stories of the Bible. God willing, we will finish the Old Testament in July. These lessons are being taught in our local church (at the *Club of Heroes*), but there are other congregations which have expressed interest in using them. **Please pray for Heavenly wisdom for the team of writers and that, by His grace, God will use these stories to change the children's lives.** Also, we need visual material to illustrate the stories. If your church has images of Bible stories and you want to support this ministry, please make contact with us through World Reach. It will be a blessing for many children.
2. Alan is writing a series of academic articles for SETECA's journal *Kairos*. The subject is "Institutionalism and the Mission of the Church". **Please pray for wisdom in producing something that is deep and academic, but, at the same time, practical.**

## Youth Ministry

1. We want to give thanks to the Lord that we have a new group of leaders for the Youth Group at the Christian Family Center. **Please pray for the spiritual life of Hannah, Cesia, Ricky, Yoel and Jacky. Pray that we can adequately train these new leaders.**
2. Our annual youth camp will be April 25-27. It will be called "Transform-Action" and our central Bible verse will be Romans 12:2. **Please pray this will be a life-changing time for the youth. Pray also for our budget, which is very tight.**
3. **Please pray for some of our teenagers who are still struggling with vices (such as alcoholism and possibly homosexuality).** We need wisdom from God. We don't know if they are attending church because they're looking for help or if they are being used by Satan to have an influence over the other kids.

1. Last February, we celebrated Kyrien's third birthday. Thank the Lord she is healthy, sweet and funny.
2. Our son, Kristian, is rapidly approaching the end of his school year (third grade). He is enjoying classes and his many friends. We are pleased to see him happy and growing toward maturity. It is a privilege to raise our children in the Lord's ways.
