BACK AT HOME - Adjusting to Our Daily Ministry

Teaching The classes are set for the Mobile Bible Institute this year. Alan will teach twice in Honduras, "Pneumatology and Eschatology", and once in Nicaragua, "Current Spiritual Movements in the Latin American Church". Alan will also teach "Apologetics" and "Introduction to Theology" in the local Bible Seminary. We will start a weekly class in our local church on the "Amazing Truths of the Bible". Dorys will be teaching and leading a group in the Joy of Service Women's Ministry. Please pray for wisdom and time to prepare carefully and with excellence for these classes.

Youth Ministry Our youth group is consistent in terms of attendance and commitment. Praise the Lord, our current attendance is 35-40! That was not the case a couple of years ago. We will be teaching a series of subjects related to growing in their spiritual walk. Dorys will work with the group of teenage girls. Please pray for the lives of these kids; that the Lord allows us to see effective changes in them.

We are part of the group in charge of planning a National Youth Leaders' Congress. Pray for our meetings (once a month).

Alan has been invited to teach in a new Institute for Youth Pastors in Guatemala City. The problem is that it requires him to be far from home for at least two months. Please pray that he can make a wise and effective decision both for the Kingdom of God and for the family as well.
