I am convinced we have good ground in these institutions to plant God's Word every day.

In the Elementary School and Kindergarten, there are smaller boys and girls with a lot of needs. Even though many of them have big problems in their homes and have bad habits, they show interest in each meeting and receive everything. It's wonderful!

Each year, we have a group of teachers dedicated to this ministry. They are like potters giving shape to the clay; making these kids into very wonderful vases.

With happiness, we have seen many children (about 60%) show big changes in their lives. This greatly encourages us.
