God has continued using me to reach out to those in Prison and in the Shelby County Jails. I am amazed at the response of the prisoners that are incarcerated. I am reminded of the time when I was in the Country of Haiti. The prison there has now collapsed and many of the prisoners escaped. I pray that the many that fell to their knees and cried out to God for salvation during the time I ministered there has not been forgotten and that they will escape the wrath that is to come.

Recently, God has put on my heart to offer churches in America my gift of evangelism by training pastors and lay people how to share their faith one-on-one. This came about because of my last two visits to Kenya, East Africa. I went there to train pastors on how to do personal evangelism before I started the teaching sessions. I asked them if, as habit of their life, they took the initiative of sharing the Gospel for the sole purpose leading people to a saving knowledge of Jesus Christ. The response of both groups that I trained was that they did not take the initiative of doing this. Jesus said in Acts 1:8, *"But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you; and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth."* So, God placed it on my heart that I travel 19 hours across the country to train people on how to share their faith and that I should offer this to pastors in the United States also.
