In the month of December 2008, I attended a Young People's Conference and four of them made a decision for Christ.

In the same month, we all attended a Camp for Young People. It was special because our children made very important decisions. My wife and I had the opportunity to teach and counsel and 2 girls accepted Jesus as their Savior.



In the month of February, I had the opportunity to teach at some churches and my wife traveled to Peru for two weeks to attend Leadership Training as we are opening a counseling center here in Cordoba, Argentina. While in Peru, she taught a ladies meeting and did some counseling with them.

We are very grateful to God that our daughter, Yamile, had a wonderful time of ministry at World Reach-Peru, taking some young ladies to the feet of Christ, counseling the adolescents and working in camp with the kids.

During the first week of March, we will start the school for training pastors and leaders. They call this place "The Forgotten Argentina" because no one goes there to preach or teach the Word of God. It is an area of limited resources and they do not have the possibilities to go to a seminar or Bible Institute.

We want to share with you something to be thankful for: After a few weeks of counseling, Aldana (the girl who wanted to commit suicide many times) made a real decision for Christ and is doing so much better.

We ask that you keep praying for us as our dream this year is to open a Prenatal Center and a Counseling Center. We need a place where we can assist and help the persons who need such help. Also, pray for the teaching and counseling we need to do this month in different churches.

Our dear brothers and sisters, we constantly need your prayers. God is working marvelously.
