

# The Acosta Family

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Cordoba, Argentina, April 2008

Thank you very much for the time you take to pray, write and send your offerings. At this time, we are now settled in the city of Santa Rosa de Calamuchita, province of Córdoba (*in the middle of Argentina*) with expectations and doors that are already opening.

I would like to share with you what we have already begun:

1. Thanks to God, we are now settled in a house in the province of Córdoba. It was a special time, but Argentina is not the same country as it was 5, 10 or even 15 years ago. There have been a lot of changes (most for the worst).
2. We have begun cultivating and renewing new and old relationships with leaders of different churches so we can start the “School of Leadership” training. We are in an inhospitable zone. It is very difficult for some of the churches to send their young people to a seminary or a Bible school.
3. We took some special time to spend with members of our family with the purpose of presenting the Gospel to them. We are happy to report that 4 of our nephews accepted Christ as their Savior.
4. Monica’s father has been listening and watching an evangelistic campaign on TV and it has encouraged him a lot. We think there has also been a change in his heart because he is showing an interest in the things of God and is attending church. (We are praying for a confirmation that he has made a genuine decision for Christ.)
5. We are teaching and counseling in different churches. It has been a wonderful time as we see the results through the changes taking place.
6. God has provided a car for the family and the ministry.
7. We found a school for our son, Andrés Esteban.
8. Our two daughters served at a camp during the months of January and February, one as a counselor and one in the dining room. Melissa finally made the decision to attend the “Word of Life Bible School” for a year and Yamile Andrea is in her last year.

Dear brothers and sisters, please do not stop praying; we need your prayers. We would like to give you more specific purposes for prayer:

- ◆ A widening of the area of our relationship with leaders and more open doors
- ◆ A retreat which will be held this month (Andrés with the men and Monica with the women)
- ◆ A trip to Columbia I need to take in order to supervise, motivate and continue the “School of Leadership” training on behalf of World Reach
- ◆ Two activities during the second week of May in 2 different churches:
  - 1) Presentation of the ministry of World Reach
  - 2) Introducing the “School of Leadership” training  
*(Our International Director will be visiting us at this time.)*
- ◆ The health of our daughter, Tatiana Melissa
