We greet each one of you with gratitude and wishes for the richest blessings. We want to take this opportunity to thank you for the support you are giving us through your prayers, finances and moral support.

During the months of August and September, Monica and I visited several churches to teach, as well as present the ministry of World Reach. As a result, we know that nine people received Christ as their personal Savior. In the month of October, I was in Peru teaching at the Mobile Bible Institute where 29 leaders attended. I also had the opportunity to teach in three churches.



Monica is very involved with the ladies of different churches in the province of Cordoba. In September, she taught at a young ladies' meeting in Buenos Aires. At the moment, she is discipling and counseling ladies of different ages. We ask you to pray specifically for a youngster named Aldana. She is 12 years old and has already attempted suicide. We also request prayers for a young couple who have consumed drugs for years and have a very sad past. Now that they know Christ, they are enjoying their first love but are still struggling with things from their past.





We are happy that our daughter, Yamile, is finishing her 3rd year at the Bible Institute and is very motivated to continue preparing herself for ministry. During the weekends, she has been serving in a village church in the province of Buenos



Aires and, through the grace of God, has led several young people to the feet of Christ. She is also discipling and giving Bible studies to young girls.

Melissa is preparing to enter the University and Andres Esteban is doing very well at school. Thank God, he is passing to the next class. At the moment, I am teaching at the Center for Reborn of Word of Life.
